### QUALIFICATIONS

1. Applicant must be a first generation student, or member of an underrepresented ethnic or racial minority, and/or show financial need.
2. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior during the spring of 2012 from a Colorado high school.
3. Applicant must enroll at a 2 or 4-year Colorado college or university in the fall of 2012 and take a minimum of 6 credit hours.
4. Applicant must have a minimum cumulative high school grade point average of 2.80 on a scale of 4.00.
5. Applicant will be selected by, but not limited to, the following criteria: leadership and community service-particularly within minority communities, past academic performance, personal and professional accomplishments, personal attributes, special abilities, academic goals, and financial need.
6. Students do not need a Social Security Number.

### INSTRUCTIONS

1. All three parts of the application must be typed or written legibly and all questions must be answered. If a question does not apply, please respond with "Not Applicable" or "N/A".
2. Provide an official high school transcript.
3. All materials must be received by Friday, March 9, 2012.
4. Please Note: A verification statement of admission from the Colorado junior college, community college, four year college or university will be required before the award will be granted for the fall 2012 semester.

Award recipients will be notified by telephone and/or mail no later than **Friday, April 6, 2012**. This award for a maximum amount of \$1,000.00 is non-renewable and contingent upon the availability of funds. Awards are competitive and will be based on the scholarship application information, the personal essay, and the individual or parental financial information. In case of ties, the postmarked date may be considered. Disbursement of funds is contingent upon enrollment at a Colorado college or university as stated in Qualifications.
